The chalking of the doors of one's house during Epiphany is a centuries-old practice throughout the world. The letters have two meanings. First, they represent the initials of the Magi — Caspar, Malchior, and Balthazar — who came to visit Jesus. They also abbreviate the Latin phrase, *Christus mansionem benedicat*: "May Christ bless the house." The chalking of the doors of our homes encourages us to dedicate our lives at home to God and to others. Seeing the symbols over our doors can help to remind us, while passing in and out on our daily routines, that our homes and all those who dwell there belong to Christ.

Epiphany House Blessing

May all who come to our home this year rejoice to find Christ living among us; and may we seek and serve, in everyone we meet, that same Jesus who is your incarnate Word, now and forever. Amen.
