Bishop Spalding has given an update with regards to public Masses. Public Masses can be resumed on May 18th with guidelines concerning Covid-19. Daily Masses will begin at St. Martha's on May 19th. Eucharistic Adoration and confession will be Tuesday through Friday from 5:30-6:30 pm and Mass will be at 6:30 pm. Saturday morning Mass will be at 8 am with Adoration and confessions from 8:30 am to 9:30 am. Saturday evening confessions will be from 4:15-5:15 pm with Mass at 5:30 pm. Sunday Mass will be at 9:30 am.

Physical distancing will have to take place so there will be some adjustments to the seating arrangements. The capacity of the church is not to exceed 50%.
